1900's-10's **ITHACA BRANCH SET:** This set is bound by two thick strips of wood on the left side, bolted together by three bolts, with a large, fancy cover sheet, showing an arched "LEHIGH VALLEY RAILROAD" and straight words underneath: "Seneca Division, TRACK ATLAS, Branches". Covers Trumansburg to Geneva Jct. 30 large 5 ft x 2 ft sheets bound, and heavy, complete as issued, including front & back cover sheets, Valuation #2330 (197) to #2356 (224). In a stunning "whiteline" on blue vellum. Minor rips & tears along edges to be expected, otherwise very good ..... \$250.

1900's-10's **MAIN LINE SET (Vicinity of Gilbert - Clifton Springs):** This set is bound by two thick strips of wood on the left side, bolted together by three bolts, with a large, fancy cover sheet, showing an arched "LEHIGH VALLEY RAILROAD" and straight words underneath: "Seneca Division, TRACK ATLAS, Main Line". The cover sheet has a lengthwise tear down the middle, but is still bound and otherwise intact. Covers 2 miles N. of Gilbert to 3 miles E. of Clifton Springs. 40 large 5 ft x 2 ft sheets bound, and heavy, complete as issued, including front & back cover sheets, Valuation #1318 (127) to #1351 (164). In a stunning "whiteline" on blue vellum. Minor rips & tears along edges to be expected, otherwise very good ..... \$350.
